What is 'Richard Dumbreck's Youth Opportunity Fund'?

In 2004 the late Richard Dumbreck very generously bequeathed his estate in Trust for the benefit of the village and its community. Money from this Trust has now been set aside to specifically help young people who live in Singleton village.

What is the money for?

It's for the young people residing within Singleton Trust Boundaries. If you are aged between 13 and 21 you may apply. The money is specifically to help fund activities and projects such as educational trips, learning a new skill or for help towards a new or existing venture i.e. equipment, tools or facilities.

What can't we fund?

- Holidays that are for pleasure and have no educational benefit.
- Core school activities (e.g. PE classes and GCSE exams.)
- Repeat Grants; We will not fund you for the same project unless it complements or adds to projects we have already funded
- Individual modes of transport (i.e. Bikes and driving lessons)

Guidelines:

- Applicants are expected to contribute financially themselves to the project.
- Applicants can apply more than once per year, although repeat applications will be subject to interview.
- Any applications over £250 will be subject to interview.

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
